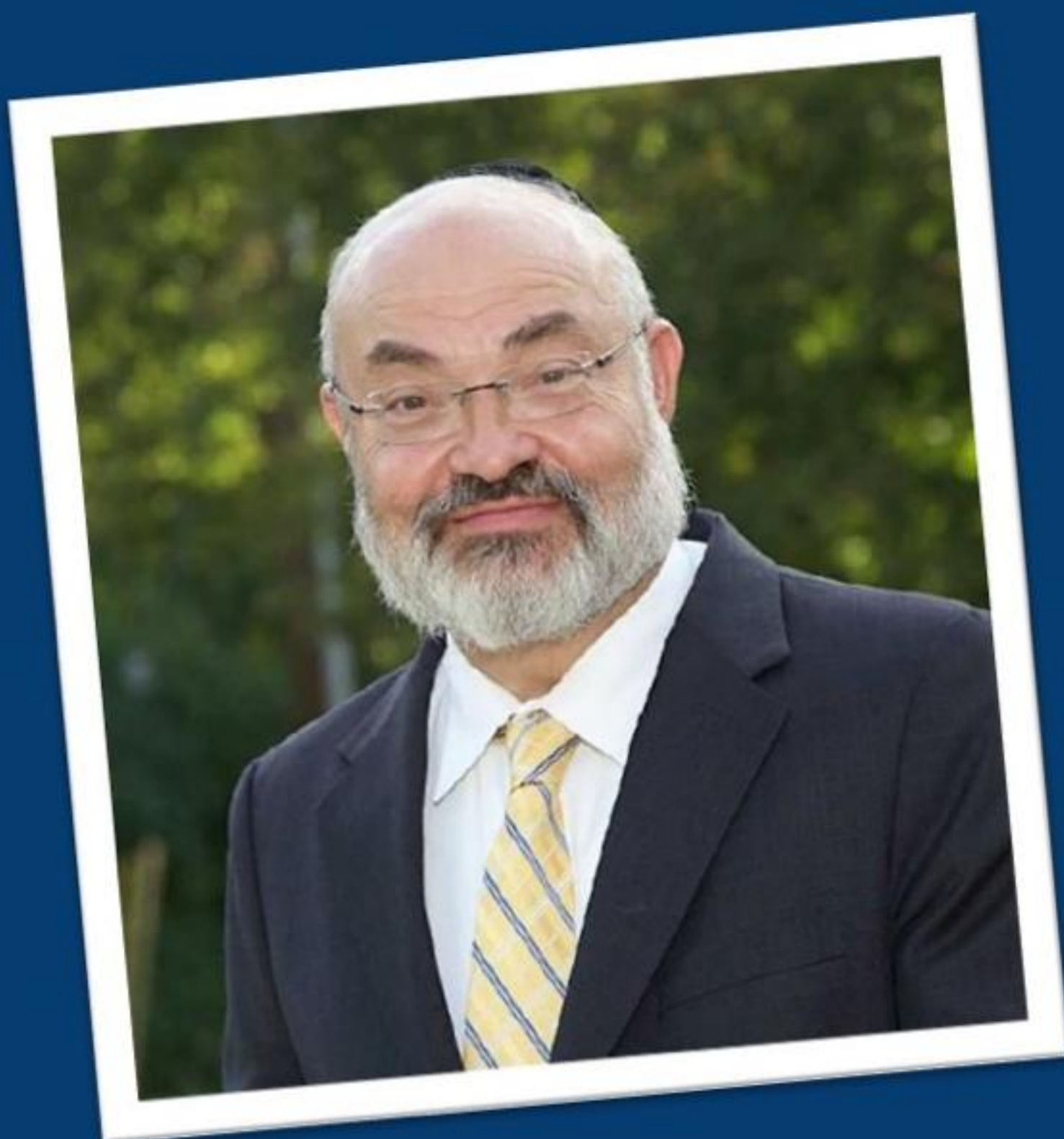

## RABBI DOVID KATZ

Rabbi Dovid Katz, PhD, is lauded for his extensive knowledge of Jewish History. He has been at the helm of Beth Abraham Congregation in Baltimore for almost 30 years. Rabbi Katz lectures at Johns Hopkins University and speaks at venues around the country. Born in Baltimore, Rabbi Katz received semicha from Ner Israel, an M.A. from Johns Hopkins University, and his PhD from the University of Maryland. His dissertation was on early modern Jewish history. Rabbi Katz has been a contributing editor and translator of the ArtScroll edition of the Talmud Bavli, and has appeared in a diverse variety of scholarly publications. Rabbi Katz is well known for his engaging and insightful lecture series and eye opening historical international tours.
